TOURNAMENT RULES 2019

1. ALL FIREFIGHTERS AND PARAMEDICS EMPLOYED FULL TIME BY A PAID FIRE DEPARTMENT ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS TOURNAMENT. RETIRED MEMBERS OF ARE ALSO ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS TOURNAMENT.
2. TEAMS SHALL CONSIST OF 4 PERSON TEAMS
3. NO BOWLER SHALL COMPETE MORE THAN ONCE IN EACH EVENT OF THE TOURNAMENT, EXCEPT, IN THE EVENT OF A LAST MINUTE EMERGENCY, THE HOST CITY CAN FURNISH A REPLACEMENT FOR THE TEAM AND DOUBLES EVENT. HANDICAP WILL BE FIGURED ON 90 PERCENT OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A BOWLERS FIREFIGHTERS TOURNAMENT AVERAGE AND 220 PINS.
4. USE YOUR USBC AVERAGE FOR THE PRECEDING SEASON, OR YOUR FIREFIGHTER TOURNAMENT AVERAGE, WHICHEVER IS HIGHEST. ALL BOWLERS NOT HAVING A USBC OR TOURNAMENT AVERAGE WILL USE AN AVERAGE AFTER BOWLING THREE GAMES IN THE TOURNAMENT. THESE AVERAGES SHOULD BE VERIFIED BY THE CITIES DIRECTORS, OR BY THE YEAR BOOK BEFORE THE START OF THE TOURAMENT.
5. HANDICAP WILL BE FIGURED ON 90% OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN YOUR AVERAGE AND 220.
6. ALL BOWLERS ARE REQUIRED TO CHECK IN 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THEIR STARTING TIME. BOWLERS ARRIVING LATE MUST START THEIR BOWLING IN THE FRAME THAT THEIR SHIFT IS BOWLING AT THAT TIME, OR UP TO THE DISCRETION OF THE HOST CITY.
7. PRIZE FEES SHALL BE RETURNED 100% PERCENT. PRIZE DISTRIBUTION SHALL BE TO THE TOP 5 IN EACH EVENT.
8. ALL PRIZE WINNINGS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING IN THE HOST CITY ON THE LAST SATURDAY IN JUNE AFTER THE TOURAMENT.
9. ANY BOWLER WISHING TO OBTAIN THEIR TOURAMENT AVERAGE SHOULD CONTACT THEIR ASSOCIATION REPRESENTATIVE.
10. ALL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRIES. TOTAL COST PER BOWLER PER EVENT SHALL BE:

DOUBLES	\$15.00	
SINGLES	\$15.00	
ALL-EVENTS	\$ 2.00	
ASSOC FEE	\$ 4.00	EVERY BOWLER MUST PAY ASSOCIATION ONE TIME
