
Tom Jozwiak Memorial Golf Outing Sponsored by South Bend Firefighters Local 362

Dear Friend,

Hope this letter finds you well during these challenging times in our lives, please let me explain why. We the members of the South Bend Firefighters Local #362 Union, in conjunction with our own South Bend Fire Department are again proud to be sponsoring the annual Tom Jozwiak Memorial Fundraiser.

Tom (Joz) was a devoted 34-year Fire Captain who lost his life on August 30, 1996 to a cruel form of Muscular Dystrophy (Lou Gehrig's disease). In a continuing effort to keep Toms' memory and spirit alive, an annual golf outing and softball tournament was organized in his name. Proceeds from these powerful charity events are donated to brother /sister Firefighters locally and throughout the state who have had medical hardships fall upon them and their families. And thanks to caring people and organizations like you we have raised over \$180,000 dollars since our inception 22 years ago.

It is again with heavy hearts that we come to your organization for help. We say that, because this year's recipients are two local heroes, Battalion Chief Bob Means suffered a traumatic Brain Injury on February 7, 2018 from snowboarding on his first day of vacation in Colorado. Bob is married and has 2 children. He spent 2 months in a Colorado Hospital in ICU (on a ventilator) and rehabilitation. Bob has yet to be released to full duty. Mike Neulieb, Michigan City Firefighter diagnosed with Colorectal Cancer and his wife diagnosed with stage 4 Lung Cancer, metastasized to her Brain. Unfortunately, she passed on April 4, 2018. They were married 35 years with 3 children and 1 grandchild.

We certainly understand the plight of today's recovering economy and the resolve of the American People to respond to this type of emergency. In a lot of ways it mirrors the duty of a Firefighter and his response to help people compassionately regardless of the situation. Firefighters are there to help with medical emergencies and motor vehicle accidents, to prevent loss of life and property in residential and commercial fires. It is the nature of the men and women that choose this profession to help, **BUT SOMETIMES THEY THEMSELVES ARE THE ONES IN NEED OF HELP AND THAT IS OUR MISSION.**
